Dear Mom,

We are having a very wet summer. There has been a lot of flooding here in Park. It seems like the water keeps pouring down until a person wonders where it all comes from.

We drove with all the family, including Mary's sister Alice, down to the border of Kachair yesterday. It is only 30 miles from here. We went down steep, twisting roads until we got low & near the river that divides the two areas. It was very steep & there was no room at all to even stop. At the bottom was a town stretched along the river. There wasn't even room for us to park & eat. They wouldn't let us cross the bridge into Kachair.

Alice is quite sick today with dysentery & some vomiting. I hope it clears up fast as we want to go to the Thylar Pass next week.

This letter is to wish you a happy birthday! Philip was 6 Aug. 3. Myra Cady is 79 years old in July.
