3 to one.

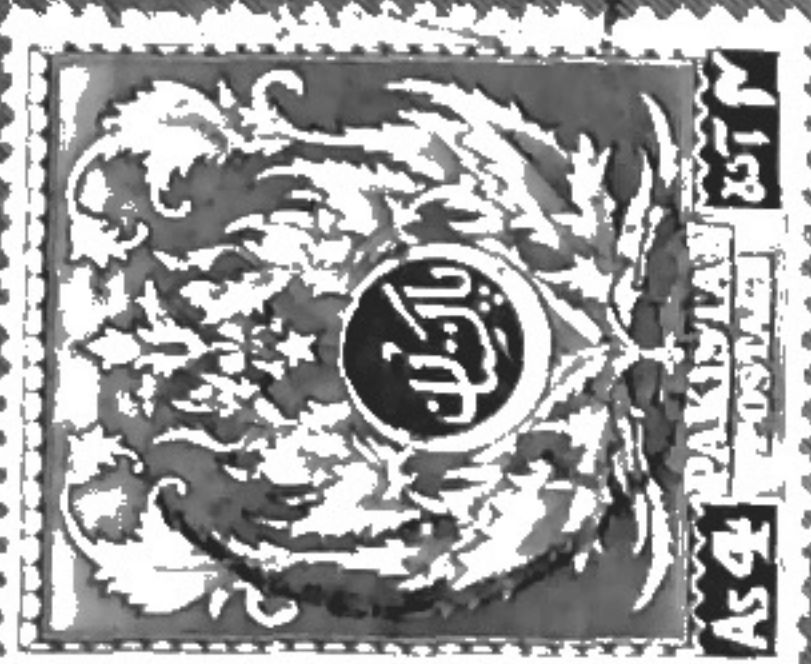
After I came back from Karachi
